Bill of Rights Context:

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; **or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.**



Freedom of Assembly

VT explanation: the right to peaceably assemble and to petition the government for redress of grievances (guaranteed by the First Amendment)

Legal Context:

In [Edwards v. South Carolina](#), the Supreme Court overturned the breach of the peace convictions of 180 African American students who had peacefully marched to the state capitol to protest discrimination.
